Background – Legal Standing

- Geneva Convention for the Protection of War Victims mandates a national information bureau
- Department of Defense authorized the creation of the Center for War Prisoner Information on 12 August 1949
- During Desert Storm the Center was known as the National Prisoner of War Information Center (NPWIC)
- Name officially changed to National Detainee Reporting Center (NDRC) on 7 January 2002

Mission Statement - NDRC

Provide total accountability and reporting of all biographic and biometric data for persons detained in association with the Global War on Terrorism (OEF / OIF)

- *Prepare reports, coordinate with and respond to requests for information from NCA, Congress, DoD, Departments of Justice & State, OGA, and ICRC*
- *Issue blocks of Internment Serial Numbers (ISN) to operational theaters*
- *SME - detainee processing & accountability (TTP/MTT)*

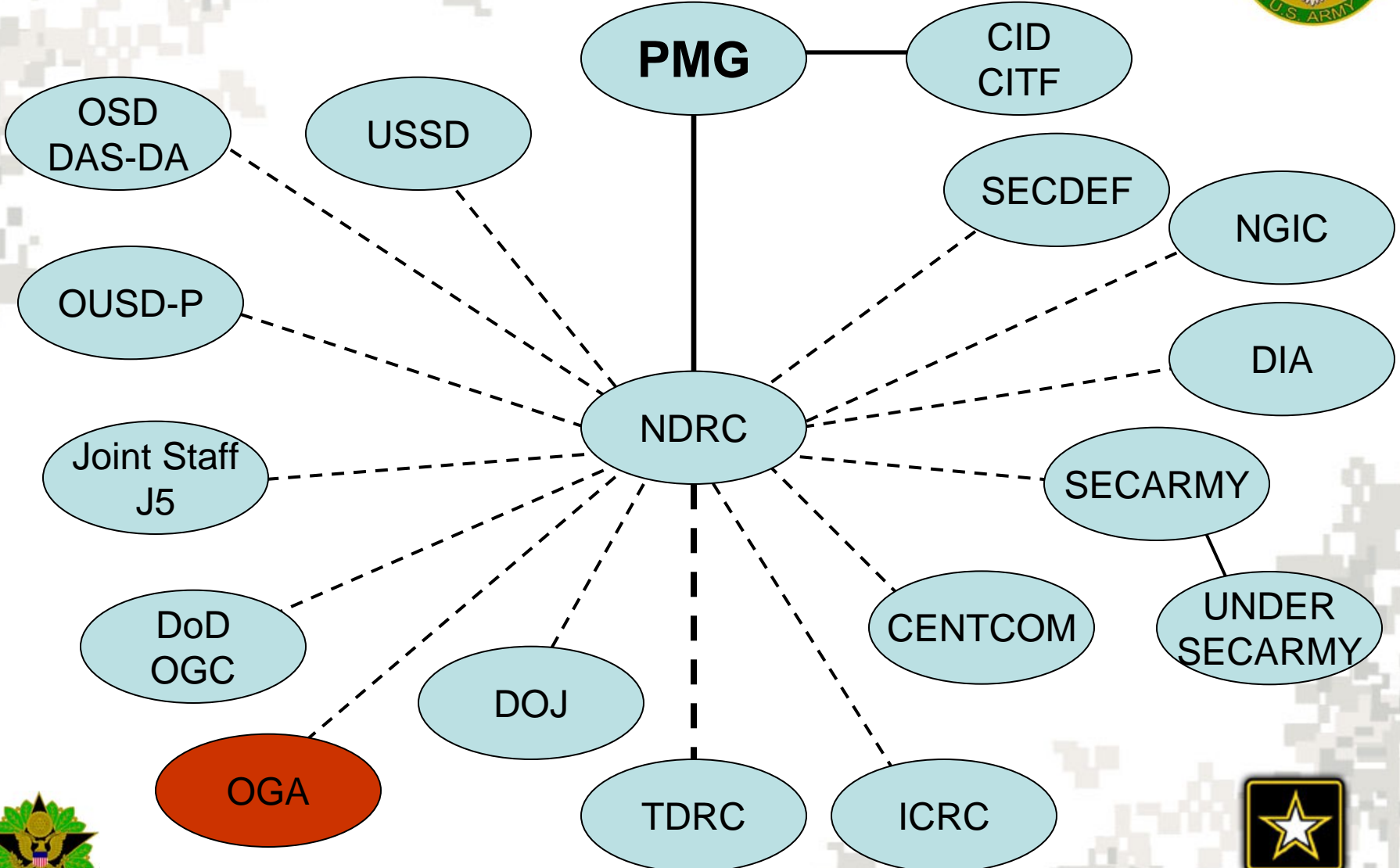

Detainee Reporting System (DRS)

- SATCOM at TIF's and TDRC increased processing efficiency
- Automated recordkeeping decreases processing time & ensures property accountability
- Detainer Option designed to ensure accurate releases & prevent inadvertent HVD releases
- Consistent baseline data between DETOPS systems (DRS, BAT, & DMS)
- UNCLAS/FOUO classification facilitates data sharing

Detainee Reporting System (DRS)

- Web based – part of COPS (OIF)
 - CONUS based & Army owned/operated stand alone server
 - Access for OGA
 - Complex query capability
- Biometric fingerprint & photograph capability that is FBI compliant
- In-facility detainee tracking (compound-to-compound)
- Jump Kit – “detainee processing kit” allows processing and ISN assignment below TIF
 - Tough Book, Cross Match, Digital Camera

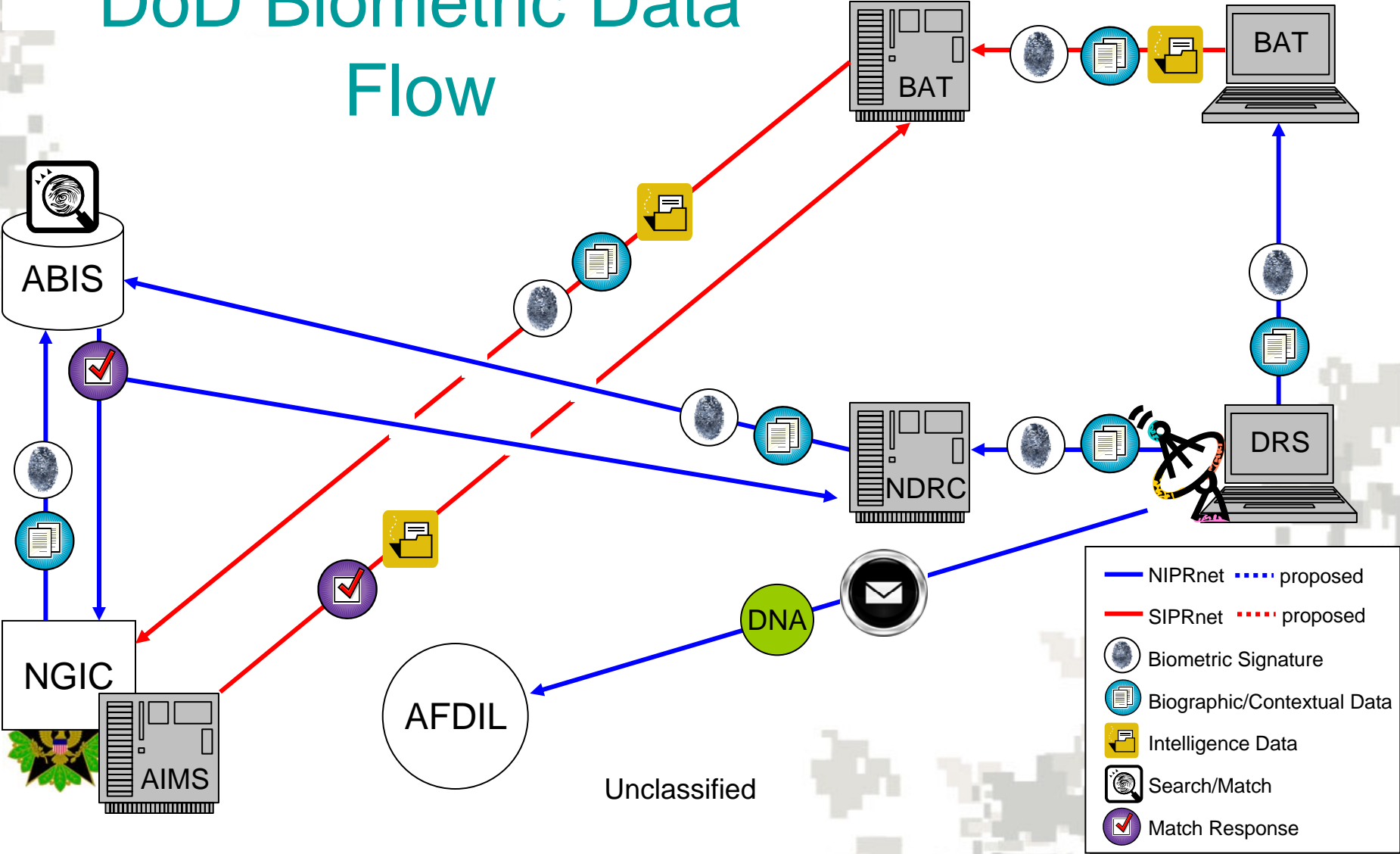

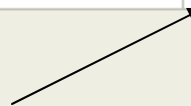

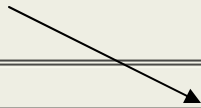
